Water Conservation—How's Your Water Pressure?

Pay attention to your water bill, and become familiar with your water meter. Use them to track your water use and detect leaks. Listen for drips and leaks around the house. If you notice a change in your water pressure, that could be a sign that you have a leak somewhere in your line. Always report changes in pressure to City Hall.

Your water meter can be a valuable tool in detecting water leaks in and around your home. Know where it is located, and follow this simple process to help determine if there is a leak in your home:

1) Make sure no water is running.

- 2) Turn off all faucets and water-consuming appliances.
- 3) Read your water meter. Write down the current reading.

4) Read the meter again a few hours later after a time when you haven't used any water. If the meter reading has changed, you have a leak.



Macedonia Community Pride

Reminder that we are entering another mowing season, & it is the responsibility of each property owner to maintain their property in compliance with City Code.

<u>Cutting Grass/Weeds</u>—The owner or occupant of any premises shall mow grass & prevent the growth of weeds & other noxious growths upon any such premises & the parkings & alleys adjacent thereto before such grass/weeds & noxious growths become a breeding place for mosquitoes, or the harboring place of filthy deposits, so as to be dangerous to the health of the community.

Failure to maintain your yard & property in compliance with City Code will result in a legal notice to abate. The City will enforce Chapter 52.01 & if necessary abate the conditions at a cost to the owner. Maintaining your yard & property shows pride in our Community!

<u>Junk Vehicle</u>—A vehicle is considered a junk vehicle if it cannot be move under its own power or has not been used as an operating vehicle for a period of thirty (30) days or more. If you want to keep the vehicle, it must be stored in a garage or other enclosed structure. Comments to the Council Members are welcomed.


Invoices are mailed out on the 1st of each month, and payment is due on the 25th. A \$10 late fee with be applied if payment is not received by the due date.

featuring Susan Brown, Beth Heaberlin, and the Bell Choir along with other various musical performances. Food will be served after our music program around noon.


