

Winter Is Here. Please Help Us Keep the Streets Nice and Clear.

Chapter 69.11 SNOW REMOVAL; STREET CLEANING. It is unlawful for any vehicle to be parked on or along any public street, avenue, alley or other public place in the City in such a manner as to interfere with street cleaning or the plowing or removal of snow and/or ice from the same.

*Chapter 135.12 DUMPING OF SNOW. It is unlawful for any person to throw, push, or place or cause to be thrown, pushed or placed, any ice or snow from private property, sidewalks, or driveways onto the traveled way of a street or alley so as to obstruct gutters, or impede the passage of vehicles upon the street or alley or to create a hazardous condition therein; except where, in the cleaning of large commercial drives in the business district it is absolutely necessary to move the snow onto the street or alley temporarily, such accumulation shall be removed promptly by the property owner or agent. Arrangements for the prompt removal of such accumulations shall be made prior to moving snow. (Code of Iowa, Sec. 364.12 [2]) Please contact City Hall if you have any questions.

Snow Removal Helpers, Thank You!

Thank you to everyone who helped with snow removal last month! Winter hit us pretty hard in January, and we wanted to make sure to thank everyone who took the time to help move snow. Whether you helped move snow on the streets, the sidewalks, or even your neighbor's driveway, thank you.

Water Conservation—How's Your Water Pressure?

Pay attention to your water bill, and become familiar with your water meter. Use them to track your water use and detect leaks. Listen for drips and leaks around the house. If you notice a change in your water pressure, that could be a sign that you have a leak somewhere in your line. Always report changes in pressure to City Hall.

Your water meter can be a valuable tool in detecting water leaks in and around your home. Know where it is located, and follow this simple process to help determine if there is a leak in your home:

- 1) Make sure no water is running.
- 2) Turn off all faucets and water-consuming appliances.
- 3) Read your water meter. Write down the current reading.
- 4) Read the meter again a few hours later after a time when you haven't used any water. If the meter reading has changed, you have a leak.

Pet License Reminder

With the ringing in of the new year comes the responsibility to renew your pet(s) license. You will need to provide City Hall with a current rabies vaccination certificate when licensing your pet. You will receive a city tag to place on your dog's collar which can help return your animal home to you in the event it becomes lost, stolen or strays away.

Information regarding the animal ordinance:

**** All dogs and cats over the age of six months must be licensed with the city and vaccinated for rabies.

**** License fee for Dogs Neutered/Spayed is \$15.00.

** Intact Male/Female is \$25.00.*

**** License fee for Cats is \$10.00.

All licenses must be renewed between <u>January 1st</u> and <u>March 15th</u> of each year, after March 15th a penalty of \$1.00 per month will be applied. All licensing is done at the Macedonia City Hall. Please call City Hall at 486-2323 if you have any questions.



Invoices are mailed out on the 1st of each month, and payment is due on the 25th. A \$10 late fee with be applied if payment is not received by the due date.
