Regular City Council Meeting

June 14, 2022

Present: Mayor Clark. Council Present: Dorr, Duede, Emge, Goos, Swope.

Mayor Clark called the Regular Council meeting to order at 7:00 pm. Pledge of Allegiance.

Motion by Swope to approve agenda, 2nd by Dorr- 5 ayes.

Paula Hazlewood of Advanced Southwest Iowa Corporation spoke on the process of starting a Community Development Foundation.

Donna Easton asked that her freezing water line be fixed before winter. Easton also spoke on the ball field and the number of trucks speeding down Main Street. Mayor Clark has been making calls in an effort to get the trucks to slow down or re-route, and the City has been in contact with the Pottawattamie County Sheriff's Department regarding the increased speeding on Main Street.

Jon Johnson spoke during Open Forum and asked that a French drain be added to the end of his driveway to prevent gravel from being washed out.

Motion by Swope to Approve Consent Agenda, 2nd by Goos- 5 ayes. The Consent Agenda consisted of May 10, 2022 Regular Meeting Minutes, May 24, 2022 Special Meeting Minutes, June Bills, May Utility Report, May Clerk and Treasurer's Reports, Sheriff's Report, and County Animal Report.

Motion by Goos to provide materials to fill gap in Jon Johnson's driveway, 2nd by Swope- 5 ayes.

Complaint reviewed regarding tall weeds at 505 Cipher Street. Motion by Dorr to send 505 Cipher a nuisance letter asking that weeds be cut, 2nd by Swope- 5 ayes.

Motion by Swope to accept Wong Antunez's bid to tuckpoint the City Hall building, 2nd by Goos- 5 ayes.

Discussion held on spending ARPA funds.

Motion by Swope to hire Wong Antunez for mowing and snow removal at wage of \$20.00 per hour, 2nd by Dorr- 5 ayes.

Motion to hire Pat Emge on contract as the water and sewer daily operator at \$20.00 per hour, 2nd by Dorr- Ayes: Swope, Goos, Duede, Dorr. Abstain: Emge.

Motion by Goos to adopt Resolution 2022-12 Set Employee Wages. Roll Call- Ayes: Swope, Goos, Emge, Duede, Dorr. Motion Carried.

Antunez spoke on snow removal in alleys this winter. Duede updated Council on necessary repairs in the concession stand bathrooms. Antunez agreed to fill potholes in City streets.

Motion to adjourn at 9:03 pm by Swope, 2nd by Dorr- 5 ayes.
