Mayor Clark called the Regular Council meeting to order at 7:00 pm. Pledge of Allegiance.

Motion by Swope to approve agenda, 2nd by Goos- 5 ayes.

Carroll Tibbles proposed the purchase of City owned land East of his 306 Main Street property. Tibbles expressed that he'd like to add a patio and seating area for the public on the lot. The Council expressed that they'd like to see a business built on the property in the future.

Motion by Dorr to reimburse Brian Reed for the cost of the 2022 OKO Fall Conference for Wastewater Training, 2nd by Goos- 5 ayes.

Duede spoke about starting a Slow Down Campaign in Macedonia. The City would like to kick off the campaign during Donia Days, and the event will be sponsored by McCreedy Implements. Motion by Goos to support Slow Down Campaign and purchase street signs to be placed at the 3 major entrances to the City, 2nd by Duede- 5 ayes.

Discussion held on high number of delinquent utility accounts.

Motion by Swope to Approve Consent Agenda, 2nd by Goos- Ayes: Swope, Goos, Emge, Duede. Abstain: Dorr. The Consent Agenda consisted of June 14, 2022 Regular Meeting Minutes, June Bills, June Utility Report, June Clerk and Treasurer's Reports, Sheriff's Report, County Animal Report, and Building Permit for 309 Debolt St.

Discussion held on Fireworks being set off after designated times. Reminder of firework courtesy to be placed in next year's newsletter.

Discussion held on increasing number of junk cars in town. Nuisance letters are to be sent out to property owners with excessive junk vehicles.

Motion by Goos to approve Resolution 2022-13 Temporary Closing of City Streets for Donia Days, 2nd by Dorr. Roll Call- Ayes: Dorr, Duede, Emge, Goos, Swope. Motion Carried.

Mayor Clark updated Council on Maintenance.

Emge updated Council on floor repairs and railing build in upstairs of City Hall. Discussion held on finding water leaks.

Motion to adjourn at 8:55 pm by Swope, 2nd by Emge- 5 ayes.
