October 8, 2024

Council Present: Mayor Clark, Duede, Swope, Croson, J. Keast arrived 7:59 pm.

Staff Present: Emge, Mahan, Antunez arrived 7:25 pm. Absent: T. Keast. Public: Ruby Bentley, Alex Alford, Monique Lowe.

Mayor Clark called the Regular Council meeting to order at 7:00 pm. Pledge of Allegiance.

Motion by Swope to Approve Agenda, 2<sup>nd</sup> by Duede- Ayes: Croson, Duede, Swope.

Alex Alford expressed interest in purchasing the 8-acre lot for sale on the southeast side of the City. Since lot is in City limits, she requested to be allowed to keep horses on the property. Council denied request due to Ordinance 55.20 Livestock.

Ruby Bentley of the Macedonia Historic Preservation Society said that the National Parks Service and Iowa Mormon Trail Association plan to provide a Mormon Pioneer National Historic Trail sign to mark the Mormon Trail in City limits. The Pioneer Trail Museum has also received a certification as a historic site designated by the National Parks Service as an interpretive facility on the Mormon Pioneer National Historic Trail.

Motion by Swope to Approve Consent Agenda, 2<sup>nd</sup> by Duede-Ayes: Croson, Duede, Swope. The Consent Agenda consisted of September 10, 2024 Regular Meeting Minutes, October Bills, September Utility Report, September Clerk and Treasurer's Reports, Sheriff's Report, and County Animal Control Report.

Discussion held regarding remaining ARPA funds. Emge will order a water meter for the fire house and contact Cahoy Pump to install new flow switch in chlorine shed.

Emge provided a water/sewer report. He has been flushing 1-2 hydrants per week.

Antunez provided a maintenance report. The truck brakes need maintenance.

Motion by J. Keast to accept Dave's Total Concrete bid to install 100' of sidewalk near the grandstand for \$4,000, 2<sup>nd</sup> by Croson- 4 ayes.

Motion by J. Keast to accept Strouf Tree Service bid of \$4,600 to remove 5 dead ash trees in ROW and grind stumps, 2<sup>nd</sup> by Croson- 4 ayes.

Mayor Clark updated Council on her attendance of the Iowa Rural Summit and the Community Foundation for Western Iowa and the Charles E. Lakin Foundation's Revitalize Southwest Iowa event. City will submit an inquiry form to the Community Foundation for Western Iowa.

Motion to adjourn at 8:50 pm by Croson, 2<sup>nd</sup> by J. Keast- 4 ayes.
