ORDINANCE 182**

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING CHAPTER 92 INCREASE LATE FEES FOR UTILITY BILLS

BE IT ENACTED, by the City Council of the City of Macedonia, Iowa:

SEC. 1. PURPOSE. The purpose of this ordinance is to amend Chapter 92, Section 92.03.

SEC. 2. Chapter 92, Section 92.03 RATES LATE FEES is hereby amended to read:

Late Payment Penalty.

SEC. 3. REPEALER. All ordinances or parts of ordinances in conflict with the provisions of this ordinance are hereby repealed. Bills Payable. Bills for combined service accounts shall be due and payable at the office of the Clerk by the twenty fifth (25th) day of each month.

Late Payment Penalty. Bills not paid when due on 25 of each month for **full amount** billed shall be considered delinquent. A late payment penalty of twenty-five dollars (\$25.00) shall be added **to each** delinquent bill.

Returned Check Fee. A returned check handling fee of Twenty-five Dollars (\$25.00) shall be added to each bill which becomes delinquent as a result of said returned check.

Discontinuance Notices. When notices are to be given or posted on the property for water, sewer and solid waste service are discontinued for nonpayment of City utility bill, a service fee of \$50.00 shall be charged to cover the cost of said notice with bill paid in full for services before the services will be turned back on.

SEC. 4. SEVERABILITY CLAUSE. If any section, provision or part of this ordinance shall be adjudged invalid or unconstitutional, such adjudication shall not affect the validity of the ordinance as a whole or any section, provision or part thereof, not adjudged invalid or unconstitutional.

SEC. 5. WHEN EFFECTIVE. This ordinance shall be in effect after its final passage, approval and publication as provided by law.
