Mayor Wax called the Regular Council meeting to order at 7:00 pm. Council present: Swope, Dorr, Keast, Goos, McCready. Staff: Duede. Public: Larry Hackett, Paul Koch, Eileen Adickes, Larry Heaberlin, Karen Heaberlin, Deb Shannon, Brian Gardelin.

Motion by Swope to approve agenda, second by Goos - 5 ayes.

Larry Hackett presented two plans for the city entrance signs. The council will go over the plans.

Eileen Adickes explained the reasons the Grist Mill will not be showing a movie in the park for Donia Day.

Karen Heaberlin and Deb Shannon had a complaint regarding the loud music from outdoor bands at The Back Forty.

Motion by Keast to accept the \$2,500 bid from Joe and Rebecca Schulz to purchase city Lot 7 Block 16, set Public Hearing for proposed sale of city property and adopt Resolution at the September 10 Council Meeting, second by Dorr - 5 ayes.

Open forum: Brian Gardelin, The Back Forty concerned no rock in the alley south of Main Street with the bike run on Donia Day. Mr. Gardelin may possibly put gavel in the alley.

Motion by Swope to approve July 9, 2019 minutes, second by Goos - 5 ayes.

Motion by Dorr to approve bills, second by Keast - 5 ayes.

Motion by Goos to approve clerk and treasurer's reports, second by Keast - 5 ayes.

Motion by Keast to approve utility reconciliation report, second by Dorr - 5 ayes.

Motion by Keast to approve outdoor Liquor License for The Back Forty, second by Swope - 5 ayes.

Motion by Goos to adopt Resolution 2019-8 Temporary Closing of City Streets for Donia Day, second by Swope. Roll call-ayes: Swope, Goos, Keast, McCready, Dorr. Motion carried.

Motion by Keast to offer Seth Tomford the maintenance operator position with the starting wage \$13 an hour, after 90 probation period an increase of .50, insurance will take effect 30 days from start date, second by Dorr - 5 ayes.

Mayor Wax discussed the Woodmancy/Hamilton Street intersection collapse issue; hired Pierce Pump to repair.

Mayor Wax discussed the contract to repair the drainage issue on Evans Street this fall.

Motion by Swope to adjourn at 8:16 pm, second by Dorr - 5 ayes.
