**Regular City Council Meeting**

**July 9, 2019**

Mayor Wax called the Regular Council meeting to order at 7:00 pm. Council present: Swope, Dorr, Keast, Goos. Absent: McCready. Staff: Duede. Public: Melia Clark, Neil Clark, Brian Gardelin.

Motion by Swope to approve agenda, second by Goos - 4 ayes.

Melia Clark owner of the Macedonia House Bed & Breakfast requested permission to install a sign at Cipher & Main Street to let people know the location of the B&B. The council discussed the location of the sign and will talk to the property owner adjacent to the right-of-way before installation.

Brian Gardelin, The Back Forty is planning a grand opening on July 20 with bands starting at 5:00 pm through 12:00 am, food tents and family activities are planned. Mr. Gardelin requested to block off Main Street for the grand opening on July 20 and also August 2 & 3 for street dances on Main Street. Motion by Swope to block off Main Street on July 20 from 5:00 pm-12 am for The Back Forty grand opening and August 2 & 3 from 9:00 pm-12 am for street dances, second by Keast - 4 ayes.

Open Forum: Josh Keast recommended that outdoor fans be installed in the ball park grandstand. The council will consider when renovating the grandstand.

Motion by Goos to approve June 11, 2019 minutes, second by Swope - 4 ayes.

Motion by Keast to approve bills, second by Dorr - 4 ayes.

Motion by Keast to approve clerk and treasurer's reports, second by Swope - 4 ayes.

Motion by Keast to approve utility reconciliation report, second by Goos - 4 ayes.

Motion by Swope to approve Resolution 2019-7 Set Employee Wages, second by Dorr. Roll call-ayes: Goos, Keast, Dorr, Swope. Motion carried.

Motion by Goos to upgrade City Hall to fiber internet with Western Iowa Networks, second by Keast - 4 ayes.

Motion by Swope to approve the merchant agreement with GovNetPay to process credit cards as a city payment option, second by Dorr - 4 ayes.

Goos discussed installing a Little Lending Library on Main Street. Motion by Swope to install a Little Lending Library in the merry-go-round area on Main Street, second by Keast - 4 ayes.

Motion by Swope to adjourn at 8:10 pm, second by Dorr - 4 ayes.
