**Regular City Council Meeting**

**June 11, 2019**

Mayor Wax called the Regular Council meeting to order at 7:00 pm. Council present: McCready, Swope, Goos, Keast, Dorr. Staff: Duede. Public: Terry Pullen, Glenna Pullen.

Motion by Swope to approve agenda, second by Keast - 5 ayes.

Terry Pullen interested in purchasing five feet of right-of-way south along his property line. The council discussed the city street measurements and decided the street is the proper size and will not sell any right-of-way.

Open Forum: Josh Keast is interested in purchasing the alley north of his property. The adjoining property owner is interested in purchasing half of the alley.

Motion by Goos to approve May 14, 2019 minutes, second by Swope - 5 ayes.

Motion by Dorr to approve bills, second by Keast - 5 ayes.

Motion by Goos to approve clerk and treasurer's reports, second by Swope - 5 ayes.

Motion by Dorr to approve utility reconciliation report, second by Keast - 5 ayes.

Motion by Keast to terminate the mowing operator due to equipment handling and safety issues, second by Dorr - 5 ayes.

Mayor Wax discussed interviewing for the open maintenance position. The mayor and two council members will be interviewing.

Mayor Wax read the Evans Street drainage bid. Motion by Dorr to accept LM Landscaping & Lawn bid of \$3,225.00, second by Keast - 5 ayes.

Mayor Wax read the bids to spray weeds in the city park & city lots. Motion by Keast to accept the lowest bid from Wax's Lawn Service of \$400.00, second by McCready - 5 ayes.

The council discussed accepting credit cards as a city payment option. Motion by Swope to accept GovPay.net terms as the payment processor, second by Keast - 5 ayes.

The council discussed the city two entrance signs and the bid from Larry Hackett. The council will invite Larry Hackett to attend the July council meeting to discuss the plans.

The clerk stated a donation of \$507.00 was received from Breda Western Iowa Network for paint and materials for the Main Street benches, merry-go-round and park equipment. Volunteers will do the work.

Motion by Swope to adjourn at 8:00 pm, second by Dorr - 5 ayes.
