Regular City Council Meeting  
Macedonia City Hall  
March 13, 2018**

Mayor Wax called the regular council meeting to order at 7:00 PM. Council present: Swope, Goos, Dorr, McCready, Keast.

Motion by Swope to approve agenda, second by McCready - 5 ayes.

Open forum - Wong Antunez discussed purchasing city land east of his property. Mr. Antunez is interested in purchasing 60-80 feet.

Josh Keast presented the idea of having movie night at the Grandstand and purchasing an inflatable screen. Mr. Keast will check into the legal rights. Mayor Wax thought the speakers were still at the ball field that could be used.

Motion by Dorr to amend agenda by moving Karen Mauer, SWIPCO ahead in the order, second by Swope - 5 ayes.

Karen Mauer, SWIPCO/SWITA presented the services available to Macedonia; Public Transit, Economic Development, Housing and Planning & Technical Assistance.

Motion by Swope to approve bills, second by Dorr - 5 ayes.

Motion by Dorr to approve Clerk/Treasurer's Report, second by Swope - 5 ayes.

Motion by Swope to approve Utility Report, second by Dorr - 5 ayes.

Motion by Goos to approve Resolution 2018-3 Local Support and Participation in a CDBG Downtown Revitalization Grant Application, second by Swope. Roll call vote: Ayes- Swope, Goos, Keast, McCready, Dorr. Motion Carried.

Mayor Wax opened and discussed the water tower bids, Goos will research grant applications for funding assistance.

Motion by Dorr to hold the city-wide clean up day by M.T.S. Inc on April 26, second by Swope - 5 ayes.

Motion by Goos to hold the city yard waste clean up day on May 9 and June 27, second by Swope - 5 ayes.

Mayor Wax reported the emergency siren tested as battery failure during the March Pottawattamie County test. Batteries have been purchased and will be installed.

Goos attended a park committee, projects were discussed; complete walking trail, pave a portion of the parking area for a half basketball court and grandstand maintenance. The park committee also discussed fundraising.

Mayor Wax attended the Riverside Optimist Club and spoke on youth activities and future development for Macedonia's city park.
