Regular City Council Meeting

March 8, 2016

Mayor Adickes opened the Public Hearing regarding the proposed 2016-2017 Budget at 7:00 PM. No public comment. Motion by Goos to close public hearing, second by Swope - 5 ayes.

Mayor Adickes called the regular council meeting to order at 7:02 PM. Council present: Swope, Dorr, McCready, Wax, Goos.

Public present: Three Riverside High School students, H Brammer, C Deakins.

Motion by Goos to approve amended agenda, second by McCready - 5 ayes.

Open forum. No public comment.

Herb Brammer and Calvin Deakins discussed the possibility of the city conveying the north/south alley between properties at 201 Dye Street. Herb Brammer said the neighborhood uses the alley regularly and would not want the alley conveyed. Motion by Wax to table this item to April's Council Meeting to research the alley usage, second by Dorr - 5 ayes.

Motion by Swope to approve February 9, 2016 minutes, second by Dorr - 5 ayes.

Motion by Swope to approve bills, second by Wax - 5 ayes.

Motion by Wax to approve Clerk/Treasurer's Reports, second by Goos - 5 ayes.

Motion by Dorr to approve Utility Report, second by McCready - 5 ayes.

Motion by Swope to adopt Resolution 2016-3 2016-2017 City Budget, second by Wax. Roll call vote: Ayes-Wax, Swope, McCready, Goos, Dorr. Motion carried.

Motion by Goos to adopt Resolution 2016-4 2016-2017 Pottawattamie Law Enforcement Contract, second by Swope. Roll call vote: Ayes-McCready, Goos, Swope, Wax, Dorr. Motion carried.

Motion by Dorr to adopt Resolution 2016-5 Support the Home Based Iowa Initiative, second by Wax.

Roll call vote: Ayes-Dorr, Goos, Wax, McCready, Swope. Motion carried.

Motion by Goos to decline request to fund the Heartland 2050 Regional Vision Project, second by Swope - 5 ayes.

Mayor Adickes opened bids to install the water tower bypass pipe, Pierce Pump 5,340, Griffin Plumbing 5,440. Motion by Goos to accept Pierce Pump bid of 5,340, second by Swope - 5 ayes.

Motion by Swope to hold the city yard waste pick up on May 11 and June 8 and hold the city clean up day on April 28, second by Dorr - 5 ayes.

Motion by Goos to purchase U.S. American Flags for Main Street, second by Swope - 5 ayes.

Clerk will research costs to treat the emerald ash borer.

Mayor Adickes read a complaint received in regards to maintaining an alley, Mayor Adickes will respond to complaint with possible solution.

Motion by Dorr to support the Macedonia Folk Art Center with a letter from the city to MHDC to match their recent grant award, second by McCready - 5 ayes.

McCready announced that he and Melinda will have the Main Street Clock repaired this spring.

Motion by Swope to adjourn at 8:20 PM, second by Goos - 5 ayes.
