Reminder that we are entering another mowing season and it is the responsibility of each property owner to maintain their property in compliance with City Code.

Cutting Weeds - Failure to maintain your yard and property in compliance with City Code will result in a legal notice to abate. The City will enforce Chapter 52.01 and if necessary abate the conditions at a cost to the owner. Maintaining your yard and property shows pride in our Community!

"Junk Vehicle" - A vehicle is considered a junk vehicle if it cannot be moved under its own power or has not been used as an operating vehicle for a period of thirty (30) days or more. If you want to keep the vehicle it must be stored in a garage or other enclosed structure.
