Trimming Trees Ordinance Reminder

It is the responsibility of each property owner to maintain their property in compliance with City Code. Failure to keep trees on, or overhanging the street, trimmed so that all branches will be at least fifteen (15) feet above the surface of the street and eight (8) feet above the sidewalks in compliance with City Code Chapter 151.03 will result in a legal notice to abate. The City will enforce Chapter 151.03 and if necessary abate the conditions at a cost to the owner. Maintaining your yard and property shows pride in our Community.
