## Winter Is Here. Please Help Us Keep the Streets Nice and Clear.

Chapter 69.11 SNOW REMOVAL; STREET CLEANING. It is unlawful for any vehicle to be parked on or along any public street, avenue, alley or other public place in the City in such a manner as to interfere with street cleaning or the plowing or removal of snow and/or ice from the same.

\*Chapter 135.12 DUMPING OF SNOW. It is unlawful for any person to throw, push, or place or cause to be thrown, pushed or placed, any ice or snow from private property, sidewalks, or driveways onto the traveled way of a street or alley so as to obstruct gutters, or impede the passage of vehicles upon the street or alley or to create a hazardous condition therein; except where, in the cleaning of large commercial drives in the business district it is absolutely necessary to move the snow onto the street or alley temporarily, such accumulation shall be removed promptly by the property owner or agent. Arrangements for the prompt removal of such accumulations shall be made prior to moving snow. (Code of Iowa, Sec. 364.12 [2]) Please contact City Hall if you have any questions.

ORDINANCE 182

### AN ORDINANCE AMENDING CHAPTER 92 INCREASE LATE FEES FOR UTILITY BILLS

BE IT ENACTED, by the City Council of the City of Macedonia, Iowa:

SEC. 1. PURPOSE. The purpose of this ordinance is to amend Chapter 92, Section 92.03.

SEC. 2. Chapter 92, Section 92.03 RATES LATE FEES is hereby amended to read:

#### Late Payment Penalty.

SEC. 3. REPEALER. All ordinances or parts of ordinances in conflict with the provisions of this ordinance are hereby repealed. Bills Payable. Bills for combined service accounts shall be due and payable at the office of the Clerk by the twenty fifth (25th) day of each month.

**Late Payment Penalty.** Bills not paid when due on 25 of each month for full amount billed shall be considered delinquent. A late payment penalty of twenty-five dollars (\$25.00) shall be added to each delinquent bill.

**Discontinuance Notices.** When notices are to be given or posted on the property for water, sewer and solid waste service are discontinued for nonpayment of City utility bill, a service fee of \$50.00 shall be charged to cover the cost of said notice with bill paid in full for services before the services will be turned back on. Passed and Approved by the City Council on October 14, 2025

Invoices are mailed out on the 1st of each month, and payment is due on the 25th. A \$25 late fee will be applied if payment is not received by the due date.
