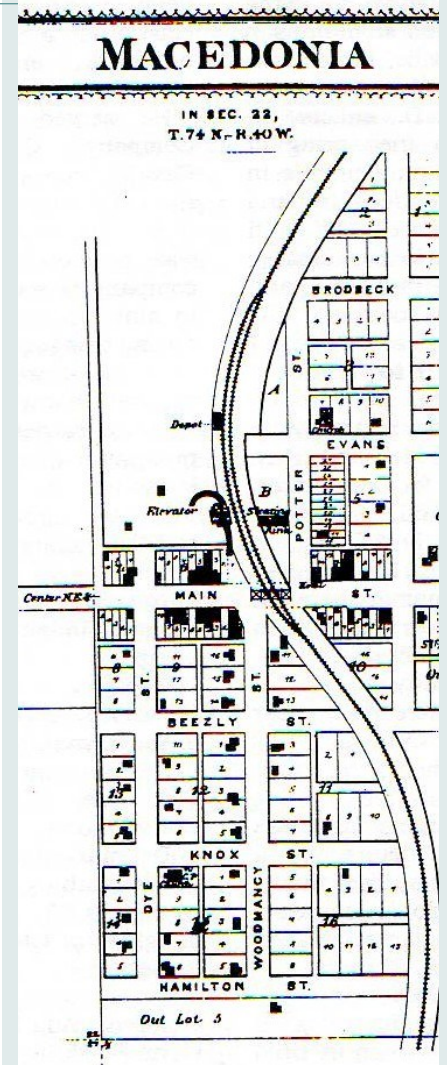
New Full-Time City Clerk Liz Alff

PET LICENSE REMINDER

Reminder it is that time of year where it comes the responsibility to renew your pet(s) license. You will need to provide City Hall with a current rabies vaccination certificate when licensing your pet. You will receive a city tag to place on your dog's collar which can help return your animal home to you in the event it becomes lost, stolen or strays away.

Information regarding the animal ordinance:

**** All dogs and cats over the age of six months must be licensed with the city and vaccinated for rabies.

**** License fee for Dogs Neutered/Spayed is \$15.00.

** Intact Male/Female is \$25.00.

**** License fee for Cats is \$10.00.



All licenses must be renewed between January 1st and March 15th of each year, after March 15th a penalty of \$1.00 per month will be applied. All licensing is done at the Macedonia City Hall. Please call City Hall at 486-2323 if you have any questions.
