

"If Walls Could Talk"

Macedonia Historical Preservation Society

When the floors of the Pioneer Trail Museum were torn up several years ago for the restoration, we had half of the floor joists removed because they were damaged by fire. We got down on hands & knees & shined a flashlight underneath to see the crawl space. (There is currently no basement in this building.)

We found evidence that there was a basement or a staircase that led next door to the basement of the old Dye Brothers' Mercantile building (two story building next door). The remains of a framed out window or door had been covered over with part of an old wooden box that had "DYE BROS CO, Macedonia, Iowa" stamped upon it. The wooden box had been nailed over the window or door opening upside down. There was also lath & plaster remnants beside the window frame!

Several of the north side Main Street buildings were connected by doorways. The General Store and the bank were at one time connected & apparently, the museum & the Dye Bros. buildings were connected as well.

Buildings change & are modified over the years, but Macedonia Historical Preservation Society is doing the best we can to preserve the original integrity of the Pioneer Trail Museum & Painted Camel buildings.

Thanks to Iowa West Foundation & other grants, these projects are being accomplished! Macedonia Historical Preservation Society is excited abut the façade restorations with the end of May being the expected completion!

Chapter 69.11 SNOW REMOVAL; STREET CLEANING.

It is unlawful for any vehicle to be parked on or along any public street, avenue, alley or other public place in the City in such a manner as to interfere with street cleaning or the plowing or removal of snow and/or ice from the same.

PET LICENSE REMINDER

You will need to provide City Hall with a current rabies vaccination certificate when licensing your pet.

Information regarding the animal ordinance:

- All dogs and cats over the age of six months must be licensed with the city and vaccinated for rabies.
- License fee for Dogs Neutered/Spayed is \$15.00.
- Intact Male/Female is \$25.00.
- License fee for Cats is \$10.00.

All licenses must be renewed between <u>January 1st and March 15th</u> of each year, after March 15th a penalty of \$1.00 per month will be applied. All licensing is done at Macedonia City Hall.



Daylight Saving Time Begins: Sunday, March 13th at 2:00 am. Turn your clocks ahead 1 hour.

Reminder: Change batteries in smoke detectors.

Invoices are mailed out on the 1st of each month, and payment is due on the 25th. A \$10 late fee with be applied if payment is not received by the due date.
