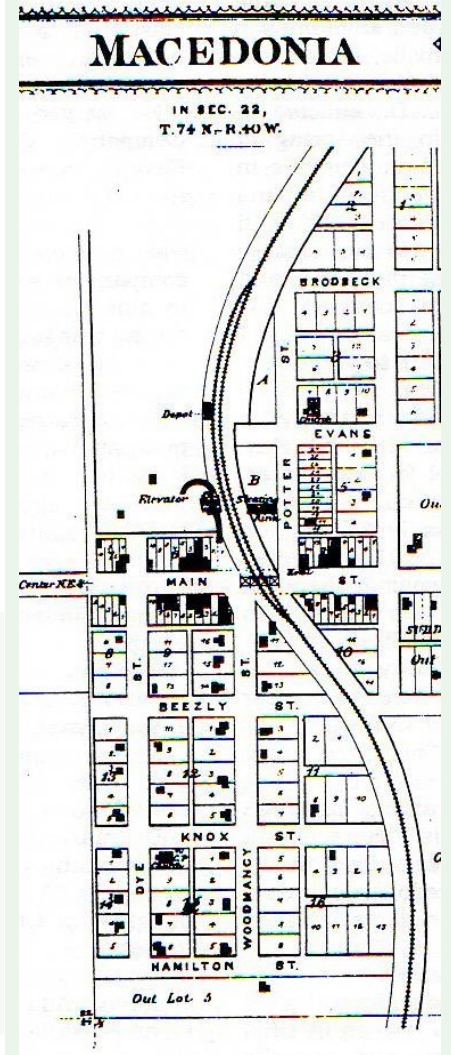
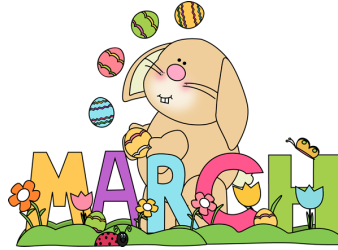

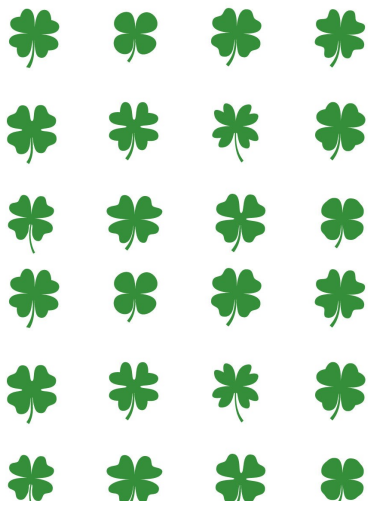

## PET LICENSE REMINDER

You will need to provide City Hall with a current rabies vaccination certificate when licensing your pet.

Information regarding the animal ordinance:

- All dogs and cats over the age of six months must be licensed with the city and vaccinated for rabies.
- License fee for Dogs Neutered/Spayed is \$15.00.
- Intact Male/Female is \$25.00.
- License fee for Cats is \$10.00.

All licenses must be renewed between January 1st and March 15th of each year, after March 15th a penalty of \$1.00 per month will be applied.  
All licensing is done at Macedonia City Hall.



**Daylight Saving Time Begins** Sunday, March 10th at 2:00 am. Turn your clocks ahead 1 hour.

**Reminder:** Change batteries in smoke detectors.

Invoices are mailed out on the 1st of each month, and payment is due on the 25th. A \$10 late fee will be applied if payment is not received by the due date.
