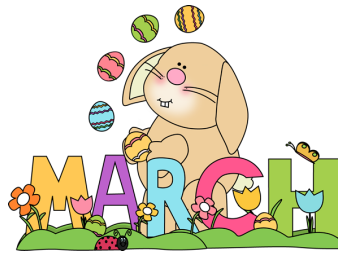

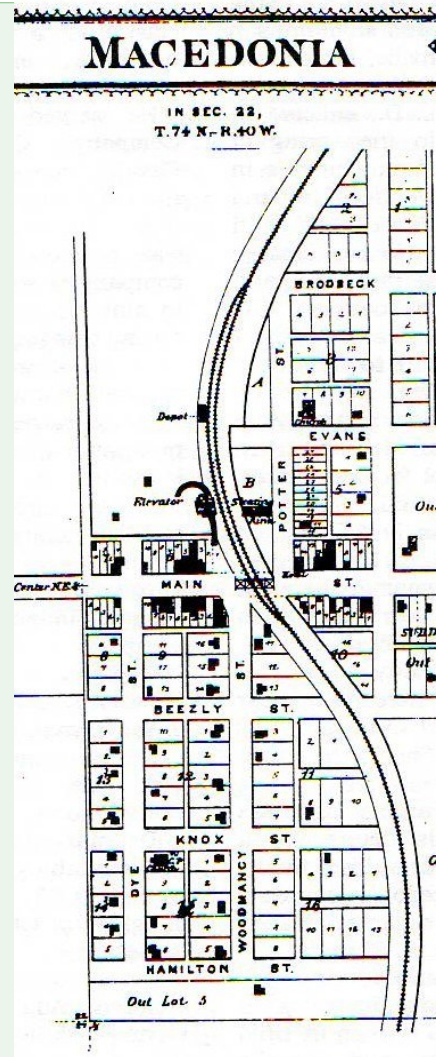

Water Bills

The City is asking that you please pay your water bills each month. If full amount is not paid in the month due, late charges will be applied and past due notices will be sent out.

As per City Ordinance: 151

SEC. 3. Chapter 92, Section 92.04 BILLING FOR WATER SERVICE is hereby amended to read:

92.04 BILLING FOR WATER SERVICE. Water service shall be billed as part of a combined service account, payable in accordance with the following:

1. Meters Read. Water meters shall be read each month.
2. Bills Issued. The Clerk shall prepare and issue bills for combined service accounts on or before the fifth day of each month.
3. Bills Payable. Bills for combined service accounts shall be due and payable at the office of the Clerk by the twenty-fifth (25th) day of the same month.
4. Late Payment Penalty. Bills not paid when due shall be considered delinquent. A late payment penalty of ten dollars (\$10.00) shall be added to each delinquent bill.



PET LICENSE REMINDER

You will need to provide City Hall with a current rabies vaccination certificate at the same time as licensing your pet.



Information regarding the animal ordinance:

All dogs and cats over the age of six months must be licensed with the city and vaccinated for rabies. License fee for Dogs Neutered/Spayed is \$15.00. Intact Male/Female is \$25.00. License fee for Cats is \$10.00. All licenses must be renewed by March 14th of each year, after March 14th a penalty of \$1.00 per month will be applied. All licensing is done at Macedonia City Hall hours are M-F 8:00am to 4:30pm.

A deposit of \$50.00 must be paid at the time of rental reservation and signature of this agreement. Deposits will be held for damage inspection and returned within one week following usage or the notification of damage. Requests for cancellation must be received at least one week prior to scheduled use. Groups without kitchen usage is only \$50.00. Groups with kitchen usage is only \$100.00. Kitchen usage is defined as use of cooking stoves, dishes and glasses, and any general use for preparation and service of foods within the building.
