## “Mormon Pioneers” Presented by Colleen Wilber

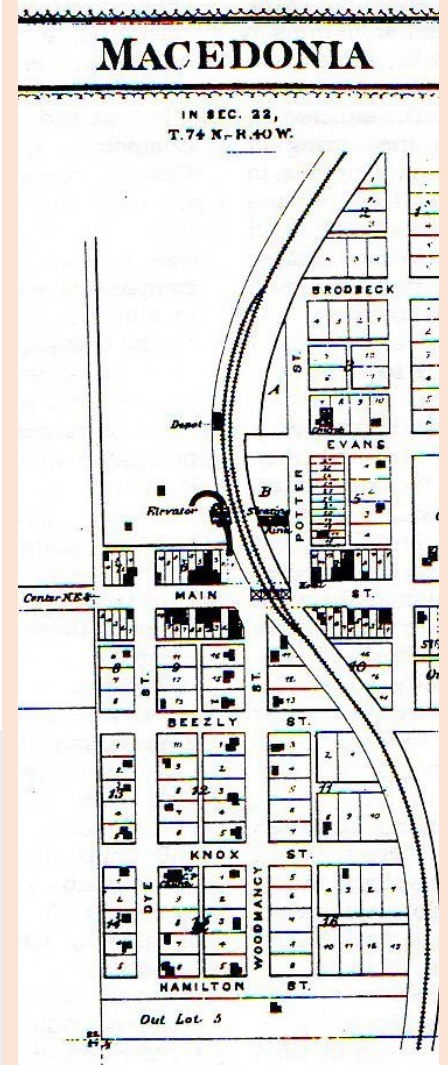
November 21, the Macedonia Historical Preservation Society is introducing the first in a series of “Throwback Thursday” programs at the Pioneer Trail Museum!

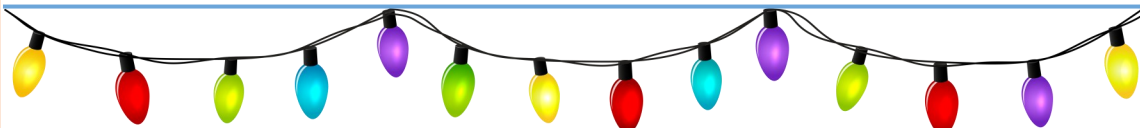
