Plastic Film Recycling Program

Macedonia is still collecting plastic for the Trex Plastic Film Recycling Challenge. We are more than halfway to our goal of 1,000 pounds of plastic. If we meet our goal, we will be awarded another Trex bench. [Collection bin is available in City Hall.](#) Be sure to remove all paper, food, & moisture from plastics before recycling.

What can be recycled?

- Grocery bags
- Bread bags
- Bubble wrap
- Dry cleaning bags
- Newspaper sleeves
- Ice bags
- Produce bags
- Wood pellet bags
- Plastic shipping envelopes
- Ziploc & other re-closable food storage bags
- Cereal bags
- Case overwrap
- Salt bags
- Pallet wrap & stretch film

DO NOT RECYCLE

- Frozen food bags
- Candy bar wrappers
- Chip bags
- Pet food bags
- Hard plastic including milk jugs, zip ties or anything similar to it.

If plastic makes a crinkly/crunchy sound in your hand do not recycle it. Thank you!

Invoices are mailed out on the 1st of each month, and payment is due on the 25th. A \$25 late fee will be applied if payment is not received by the 25th.
