Fall Harvest Hot Beef Sandwich Dinner by Macedonia Heart & Soul with TS Bank

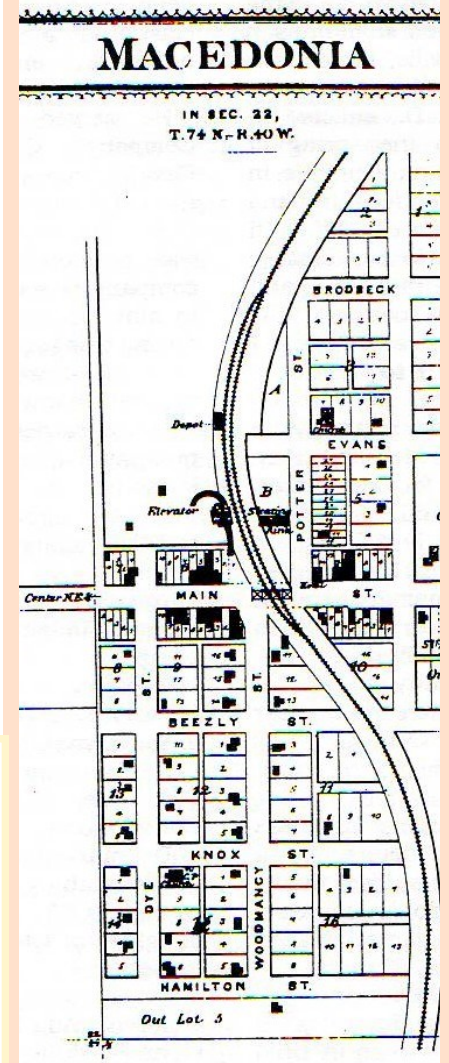

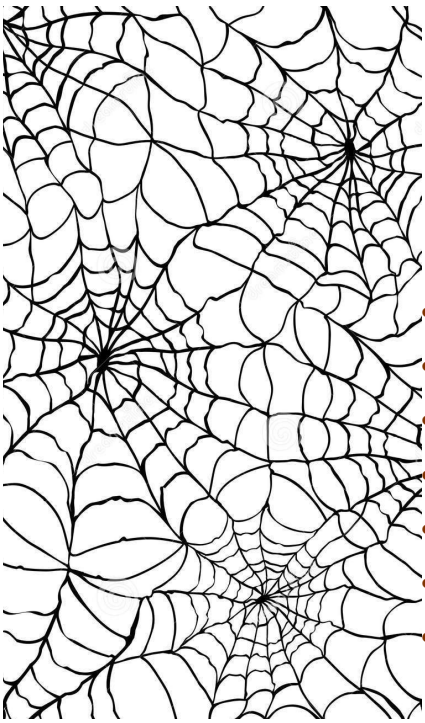

Collection bins are available in City Hall & The Pioneer Trail Museum. Be sure to remove all paper, food, & moisture from plastics before recycling.

What can be recycled?

- Grocery bags
- Bread bags
- Bubble wrap
- Dry cleaning bags
- Newspaper sleeves
- Ice bags
- Produce bags
- Plastic shipping envelopes
- Ziploc & other re-closable food storage bags
- Cereal bags
- Case overwrap
- Salt bags
- Pallet wrap & stretch film
- Wood pellet bags
