Mayor Wax called the Regular Council meeting to order at 7:00 pm. Council present: Swope, Goos, Dorr, Keast, McCready. Staff: Duede. Public: Ed Adickes, Kathy Noble, Steve Noble.

Motion by Goos to approve agenda, second by Swope - 5 ayes.

Josh Keast and Kathy Noble, Assembly of God Church request the city to convey the alley between properties 501/507 Dye Street and 305 Dye Street according to city code. Motion by Dorr to convey the alley between 501/507 Dye Street and 305 Dye Street, second by Swope - 5 ayes.

Open forum: Ed Adickes will consider plowing snow with the town equipment for the city until the maintenance operator has been hired.

Motion by Swope to approve October 8, 2019 minutes, second by Dorr - 5 ayes.

Motion by Goos to approve bills, second by Keast - 5 ayes.

Motion by Keast to approve clerk and treasurer's reports, second by Dorr - 5 ayes.

Motion by Goos to approve utility reconciliation report, second by Swope - 5 ayes.

Council discussed the open maintenance operator position. Motion by Dorr to advertise the full-time maintenance position starting 15.00 an hour with benefits in The Herald, Post Office, IA Workforce and Facebook, second by Keast - 5 ayes.

Council discussed snow removal, snow plow and tires. Motion by Keast to hire Ed Adickes for snow removal at 15.00 an hour until the open maintenance position is filled, second by Swope - 5 ayes.

Motion by Swope to purchase tires for the pickup, second by Dorr - 5 ayes.

Motion by Dorr to purchase tires for the skidloader, second by Swope - 5 ayes.

The city purchased a spreader and trailer for 500.00 for snow removal. Motion by Keast to service the sander to get it up and running, second by Goos - 5 ayes.

Motion by Goos to adopt Resolution 2019-14 Approve City Annual Finance Report Year Ending June 30, 2019, second by Swope. Roll call-ayes: Swope, Goos, Keast, McCready, Dorr. Motion carried.

Goos reported the CITIES application submitted last month for the grandstand renovation will be included in the application to Iowa West. Goos and Wax met with Pete Franks to approve the renovations for the Stempel building. The DTR project is scheduled to start spring 2020.

Mayor Wax reported Carson has extra water meters and readers that are available, Carson is interested in trading 30+ water meters and readers for the recycling trailer. Motion by Keast to trade the recycling trailer for the 30+ water meters and readers with Carson, second by Goos - 5 ayes.

Motion by Swope to adjourn at 8:50 pm, second by Dorr - 5 ayes.
